Den 5 – Webelos I


Den 5 Webelos have been hard at work completing their Engineer adventure. They started out working individually to build catapults without plans. After a lot of trial and error, 30 feet of tape, dozens of rubber bands, and all of our popsicle sticks, almost everyone's was working successfully. The kids agreed planning things in advance is a far better approach! So that's just what they did at home, by drawing blueprints and building their own

project. The only requirement was that it follow their plans and had to fit into a shoebox.

During our next meeting, to make things even more difficult, the kids broke up in teams to build parts for a stomp rocket airplane launcher. Their only resources were a set of vague plans and a box of parts (including many extras). Miraculously all three groups came together and the launcher worked!

During our final week the kids

researched the history of airplane wings and learned about the different shapes, positions, and every crazy combination seen during the previous 100 years. With this in mind, each Scout worked to implement a rocket plane with the perfect set of wings then competed in races for speed and distance.
